We enjoy a 2023 Top-Rated Great Non-Profit designation and are a Platinum Guide Star facility supporting both Therapeutic Riding and Hippotherapy.

THERAPEUTIC RIDING

... is an equine-assisted activity that teaches riding skills to people with a diagnosed disability for the purpose of contributing positively to their cognitive, physical, emotional, and social well-being. The riders must learn to balance in the saddle, distribute their weight equally in each stirrup in order to sit properly during the horses' different gaits, and use reins and leg aids correctly to communicate with the horse.

The focus of Therapeutic Horseback Riding is on improving riding skills and setting riding goals.











HIPPOTHERAPY

... refers to how occupational therapy, physical therapy and speech-language pathology professionals utilize equine movement as a therapy tool to engage sensory, neuromotor and cognitive systems to promote functional outcomes in the rider. Classical Hippotherapy relies on the movement of the horse to influence the rider and stimulate the riders' muscles to improve posture, balance, and trunk control.

The focus of Hippotherapy is on treatment of the disability and setting therapy goals.
